Executive Summary

In the identified area, the current year population is 80,219. In 2010, the Census count in the area was 75,568. The rate of change since 2010 was 0.96% annually. The five-year projection for the population in the area is 84,091 representing a change of 0.95% annually from 2015 to 2020. Currently, the population is 47.2% male and 52.8% female.

Median Age

The median age in this area is 31.9, compared to U.S. median age of 37.9.

Persons of Hispanic origin represent 3.6% of the population in the identified area compared to 17.6% of the U.S. population. Persons of Hispanic Origin may be of any race. The Diversity Index, which measures the probability that two people from the same area will be from different race/ethnic groups, is 54.0 in the identified area, compared to 63.0 for the U.S. as a whole.

Current median household income is \$38,394 in the area, compared to \$53,217 for all U.S. households. Median household income is projected to be \$37,600 in five years, compared to \$60,683 for all U.S. households

Current average household income is \$56,198 in this area, compared to \$74,699 for all U.S. households. Average household income is projected to be \$58,015 in five years, compared to \$84,910 for all U.S. households

Current per capita income is \$22,937 in the area, compared to the U.S. per capita income of \$28,597. The per capita income is projected to be \$23,680 in five years, compared to \$32,501 for all U.S. households

Currently, 45.5% of the 34,113 housing units in the area are owner occupied; 43.6%, renter occupied; and 10.9% are vacant. Currently, in the U.S., 55.7% of the housing units in the area are owner occupied; 32.8% are renter occupied; and 11.6% are vacant. In 2010, there were 31,992 housing units in the area - 47.2% owner occupied, 41.8% renter occupied, and 11.0% vacant. The annual rate of change in housing units since 2010 is 2.89%. Median home value in the area is \$145,069, compared to a median home value of \$200,006 for the U.S. In five years, median value is projected to change by 0.27% annually to \$147,019.
